Have you been skating outdoors? If you have then it will be time to get your skates sharpened for this half of the season. Ice made indoors is made and is kept at certain temperatures. It is softer than outdoor ice and so the sharp blade does not have to work as hard to cut into the ice as we push off to glide. Outdoor ice is affected by outside temperatures and so is naturally harder meaning the blades work harder and dull at a much faster rate. You will have to have your skates sharpened twice as much if you skate on an outside compared to an inside rink.
